She enrolled in the CHA Employment Placement Services (EPS) program through Employment and Employer Services (E&ES). Umeko was interested in customer service. The WORC office established a partnership with the Chicago Lighthouse to fast-track residents as Customer Service Agents. Her Career Coach encouraged her to apply, and she immediately submitted an online application. Within days she was interviewed, hired and started working immediately.

I went from working outside in cold weather without any benefits and little time for my child to being accepted for a full-time job as a customer service representative with the Chicago Lighthouse. Now, I can work from home with full benefits and have the time to take my daughter to school.
